POSITION SUMMARY

The Psychiatric Prescriber is an integral part of the trans-disciplinary ACT Team, as well as other programs for CHOICES, Inc., providing primary health care to clients to promote wellness, recovery, and rehabilitation. Responsibilities are implemented within the framework of agency policy, professional ethics, legal scope of practice, and regulatory guidelines.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

(Responsibilities, Accountabilities, and Competencies: May not include all duties of this job)

A. JOB DUTIES

1. Provide comprehensive and holistic primary care, including: physical exams, development of diagnoses, management of acute and chronic psychiatric illnesses
2. Evaluate outcomes of care and make medical recommendations
3. Supervise Nursing staff
4. Prescribe and evaluate psycho - pharmacological treatment regimen
5. Collaborate with other health care providers and makes appropriate referrals
6. Develop, maintain and update plans of care and health care records
7. Teach health promotion measures to clients and staff.
8. Able to meet billing requirements required by Supervisor.
9. Advocate for client in accessing and navigating the health care system
10. Work closely with the team and client in establishing and following the optimal treatment/service plan
11. Participate in check-in meetings and case-reviews, and consults with team members as needed
12. Collaborate with nursing staff to coordinate prescriptions and orders, and to oversee the overall mental and physical health of the clients
13. Establish a work schedule, in collaboration with team leaders to ensure that clients are seen in a timely manner
14. Engage identified clients in mental health/psychiatric services, both on site and in the community and make appropriate referrals for medical services as required
15. Educate/Assist agency staff to develop/increase awareness of community health care agencies/resources

16. Serve as health care resource to clients and families/significant others
17. Participate in facilitating appropriate hospitalizations (medical and psychiatric), crisis interventions and referrals
18. Communicate with hospital staff to ensure optimal treatment and discharge planning.
19. Establish/Lead education and support groups on health-related topics, in the Health & Fitness Initiative, e.g. mental illness, psychiatric medications, nutrition, safe sex, obesity and smoking cessation.
20. Provide in-services and trainings for the staff
21. Perform other related work as assigned.
22. Take on – call 24-hour crisis phone from time to time
